



## **Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Annual Report**

### **PREA Standard § 115.313d Data review for corrective action.**

- (3)** Preparing an annual report of its findings and corrective actions the agency as a whole.
  - (b)** Such report shall include a comparison of the current year's data and corrective actions with those from prior years and shall provide an assessment of the agency's progress in addressing sexual abuse.
  - (c)** The agency's report shall be approved by the agency head and made readily available to the public through its website or, if it does not have one, through other means.

### **2015-16 Corrective Actions**

- **Appointed Facility PREA Compliance Manager:** To work in collaboration with PREA Coordinator, Asst. Administrator, and Administrator.
- **Updated Youth Education Materials:** To include but not limited to, Youth Brochures (English and Spanish), Youth Handbook, and PREA Posters.
- **Youth PREA Education Groups/Information Sessions:** Every youth received PREA Education during their stay in the facility.
- **Employees completed mandatory PREA Training:** Every agency employee was mandated to attend an in-service training that included a two hour PREA training. Trainings were conducted by the PREA Coordinator and/or the PREA Compliance manager.
- **PREA Youth Education:** Facility-wide trainings were completed. Every youth at the facility received updated information on PREA to include but not

limited to, Youth reporting, access to outside services, investigations protocol, etc.

- **Internal PREA Pre-Audit:** PREA Audit completed to determine compliance with PREA standards. Audit completed by the PREA Coordinator.

### **Recommendations**

- ❖ **Increase camera coverage:** Camera assessment was completed by the administrator and support staff to determine the need of additional cameras. Assessment was submitted to the Board of Supervisors Office.
