## THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE ELECTION (PPE)

The Presidential Preference Election (PPE), is an election in which voters can choose who they would like to be their presidential candidate in the upcoming General Election.

### ONLY VOTERS REGISTERED WITH THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY CAN VOTE IN THE PPE

- INDEPENDENTS AND VOTERS not registered as a member of a participating party are not eligible to vote in the PPE.
- The Democratic Party is the only party participating in the PPE.

- Tuesday, February 18 - Last day to register to vote
- Wednesday, February 19 - Early voting begins
- Friday, March 6 at 5pm - Last day to request early ballot by mail
- Friday, March 13 at 5pm - Last day to vote early in person

### PRIMARY ELECTION TUESDAY, AUGUST 4 - ELECTION DAY

- Monday, July 6 - Last day to register to vote
- Wednesday, July 8 - Early voting begins
- Friday, July 24 at 5pm - Last day to request early ballot by mail
- Friday, July 31 at 5pm - Last day to vote early in person

### GENERAL ELECTION TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3 - ELECTION DAY

- Monday, October 5 - Last day to register to vote
- Wednesday, October 7 - Early voting begins
- Friday, October 23 at 5pm - Last day to request early ballot by mail
- Friday, October 30 at 5pm - Last day to vote early in person

### ONLINE

Register to vote or update your existing voter registration online at [ServiceArizona.com](http://ServiceArizona.com). You'll need an Arizona Driver License or Identification Card to do so.

### PRINT

Print a voter registration form from the Graham County Recorder's website at: [graham.az.gov/302/Voter-Registration](http://graham.az.gov/302/Voter-Registration).

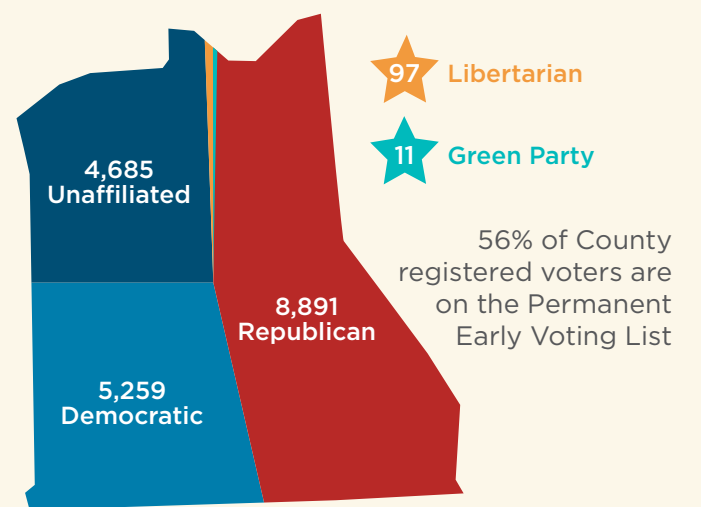
### PHONE

You must update your voter registration any time your home address, name, or political party preference changes. **Election mail is not forwardable.** It's important to keep your mailing address current with our office, even if you are only temporarily away.
